Acts 8:4-13

⁴Therefore, those who had been scattered "came through" "good-newsing" the word. 5Philip "came down" to the city of Samaria and was proclaiming Christ to them. 6The crowds with one accord were giving attention to what was said by Philip, as they heard and saw the signs which he was performing. ⁷For *in the case of* many who had unclean spirits, they were coming out of them shouting with a loud voice; and many who had been paralyzed and lame were healed. 8So there was much rejoicing in that city. ⁹Now there was a man named Simon, who formerly was practicing magic in the city and "amazing" the people of Samaria, claiming to be someone great; ¹⁰and they all, from smallest to greatest, were giving attention to him, saying, "This man is what is called the "Mega Dynamo" of God." 11And they were giving him attention because he had for a long time "amazed" them with his magic arts. ¹²But when they believed Philip "good-newsing" about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were being baptized, men and women alike. ¹³Even Simon himself believed; and after being baptized, he "devoting to" Philip, and as he observed signs and "mega dynamos" taking place, he was constantly amazed.
